Scott informs viewers BNI #2 will include a solo set, Brian Blessed's quiz and a special guest in the first half, while the second half will be 'full of surprise'.

A free download code from Bandcamp is announced as this week's Shit Raffle prize.

BNI #2 Aftershow video title on Facebook: Post show bit...CHEERS!

It opens with Scott and Amanda standing side by side holding small woollen dolls of themselves, created by Lindsey Smith.

The dolls are referred to as Little Scott and Little Amanda. It's also mentioned that there's a Little Alan, a Little Bjorn and a Little Devil.

At peak time, Scott notes, there were about 850 viewers watching BNI #2.

He announces he's run out of Guinness, which is why he's now on the whiskey.

The whiskey is a birthday present from Amanda as it was the only thing she could think to buy due to the lockdown situation and 'non-essential' shops being closed.

Scott declares It Must Be Love by Labi Siffre as one of his favourite songs on the planet and reveals it's one of the first he learned on the ukulele. "It's a singalong," he says, and encourages audience participation. Amanda joins in during the chorus. And she makes Little Scott (the doll) dance in front of the camera near the end of the song.

"Thank you very much. God bless from me, Amanda, Little Scott and Little Amanda. Erm. Yeah, it's been a great night...erm...and er...for those of you that are still playing the drinking game...cheers!"

He takes a slug of whiskey. Raises his glass to the camera. Amanda says "Applause" in a German accent. This cracks them both up and Scott nearly spits his whiskey back out.

Scott then turns the camera round and zooms in on one of the only birthday cards he's received this year - a grumpy looking alpaca on a green background. "Beauty innit?" he says. Amanda laughs.

Ends: "God bless. Goodnight!"
